### The Female Inventory System (FIS)

The Blonde d'Aquitaine Society uses a female inventory system which accounts for calf registration fees.

At the commencement of each new financial year (1st July) FIS is printed for each grade of female in your herd.

Details list the number of active breeding females, above 24 months of age at the 1st July, which are known to be in your herd. Please refer to the Fee Schedule for current charges that will be applied.

Payment of the female inventory makes each female "active" for the following 12 month period. There is no further charge to register calves born naturally to "active" females. However a surcharge is applicable to register any calf born during this same period by embryo transfer (ET) to an "active" female.

An Invoice for Female Inventory has been issued and you are invited to adjust the account, if necessary, by:

- (a) Deleting any animals that have been sold, died or from which you do not intend to breed stud progeny in the future;
- (b) Adding any animals which have not been included on the "active" list; or have been previously marked "inactive" and now are requested back into the "active herd."

NB: Early payment discount applies when FIS is paid before 31<sup>st</sup> August. A 10% discount for herds with less than 50 active Blonde breeders and 25% discount for herds with over 50 active Blonde females of any grade combination.

\*\*in addition to the reinstatement fee, payment of FIS fees is required for any previous years that female has been active.
